

## Community Health Centers employ thousands of New Yorkers!

The people who work  
there are not just doctors and nurses,  
they are community members who know  
their neighbors' needs. Many health centers  
hire care managers to connect patients  
to essential community-based services.

**21,000+ FTEs**

**5 year FTE increase:**  
**66% overall**  
**104% behavioral health**
