


INSURANCE COVERAGE OF NYS FQHC PATIENTS


INCREASING ACCESS

In the five years since the implementation of the Affordable Care Act, 690,000 additional New Yorkers have access to primary care at an FQHC.




PARTNERING WITH GOVERNMENT TO SERVE THOSE IN NEED
