

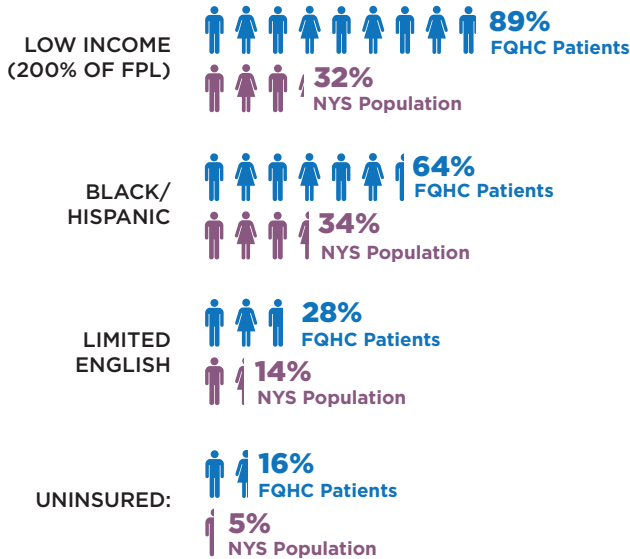

FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS:

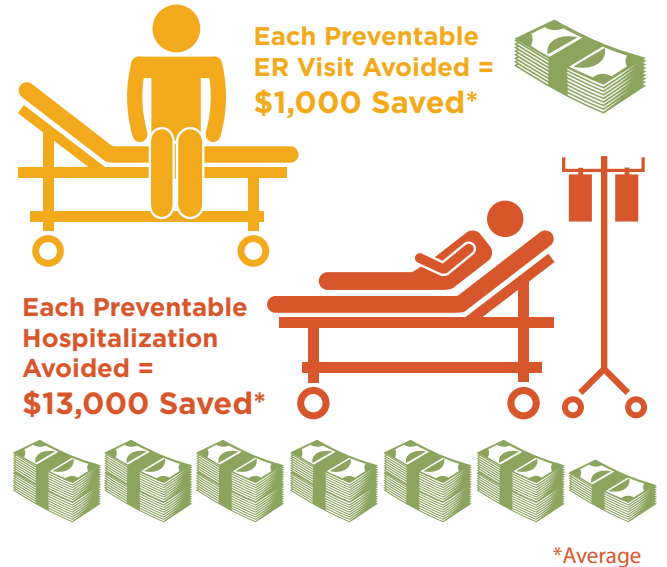
➔ PROVIDE HEALTH CARE FOR EVERYONE

FQHCs provide health care to everyone, regardless of insurance, immigration status, or ability to pay.



➔ SAVE MONEY THROUGH COMPREHENSIVE CARE

FQHCs build healthier communities by providing high-quality comprehensive care that prevents unnecessary ER visits and hospitalizations.



➔ CREATE JOBS

FQHCs employ thousands of people in low-income communities, but they struggle to recruit and retain staff in certain key positions.
