

Medical Supplies




Information Technology

changes in care models


It's been 24 years since NYS set CHC Medicaid reimbursement rates. It's time to change the formula and raise the rates!

Community Health in New York State


2.3 million New Yorkers get their health care from Community Health Centers (CHCs) each year.

CHCs care for their patients at **800+ locations** statewide. Most are in underserved and under resourced communities.

CHCs serve everyone, regardless of insurance, immigration status, or ability to pay.



68% of CHC patients identify as Black, Indigenous, or other people of color.



Governed by patients and staffed by neighbors, CHCs support health equity.

An investment in CHCs is an investment in NY's health equity agenda.
