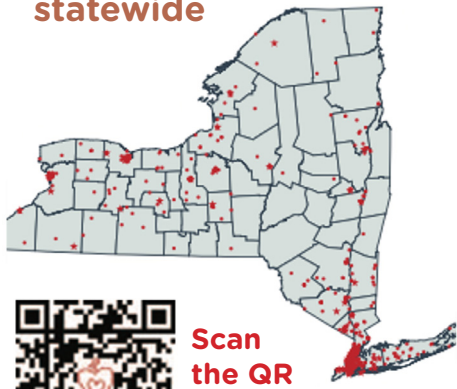


NYS COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS 2026 FACTS >

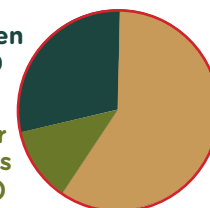

In 2024, New York State's Community Health Centers contributed **\$8 billion** to the state's economy and supported approximately 43,700 jobs statewide.



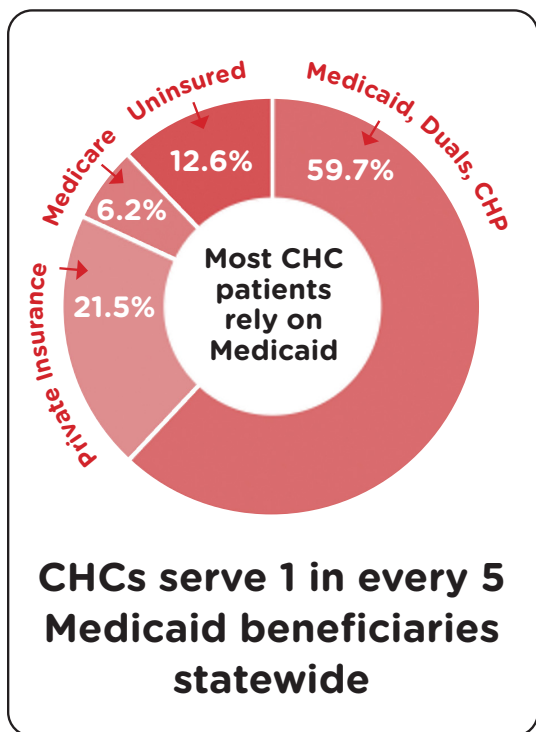

CHCs dedicated \$445 million in 2024 to providing essential care for uninsured and underinsured New Yorkers.

CHCs serve 1 in 3 Uninsured New Yorkers

The majority of them live in poverty:

70%

live at or below the Federal Poverty Level

That's \$15,650 for a single adult and \$32,150 for a family of four

And nearly 117,535 (4.7%) are unhoused
