



# PLANNING SECTION CHIEF (PSC) – CHC ALL- HAZARDS JOB ACTION SHEET



*(Updated using EOP Sections 3.1-3.6, 4, 6-7, 9, and clarification that PSC is usually Facilities or COO)*

## Suggested Role Assignment (CHC specific)

Typically filled by:

- Facilities Director/Manager
- COO
- Director of Operations
- Safety Officer (EH&S)
- Alternate: Quality/Compliance staff or any staff trained in documentation and communication

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## When to Activate PSC

Activate when ICS is activated and incident requires:

- Information collection
- Documentation
- Situational awareness
- Status reporting
- Multi-site coordination
- Facility/utility impact assessment (EOP 3.5, 6.1-6.5)

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## PSC Role in ICS

PSC reports directly to the Incident Commander and supports:

- Situation Status
- Documentation
- Planning for operational periods
- AAR/IP inputs



## 👉 Role Interaction Map

- **PSC ↔ IC:** Provides consolidated status + recommended objectives
  - **PSC ↔ Operations:** Receives field/site updates
  - **PSC ↔ Logistics:** Tracks resource needs if assigned
  - **PSC ↔ CHCANYS:** Prepares information for VEOCI reporting
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## 🎯 Mission

Collect, analyze, and document incident information; maintain situational awareness; support IC decision-making; consolidate updates; prepare SITREPs, logs, and after-action inputs. (EOP 3.5)

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## 🌟 Immediate Actions (0-2 Hours)

- Receive IC briefing: incident type, affected sites, immediate risks, initial objectives (EOP 3.3)
- Review this JAS
- Determine which functions are needed:
  - Situation Status
  - Documentation
  - Optional Resource Tracking
- Establish update collection process: who reports, when, and how
- Begin Situation Status Log (EOP 3.5 requirement)
- Select documentation format: Internal CHC logs, or CHCANYS Report Template (ERL)
  - Support IC in setting operational period
  - Document initial impacts and unmet needs (EOP 6.3–6.5)



## Intermediate Actions (2–12 Hours)

- Maintain situational awareness
    - Facilities (power, HVAC, water) (EOP 6.1–6.5)
    - IT/EMR
    - Staffing (EOP 7.3)
    - Clinical disruptions
    - Safety/security issues
  - Consolidate updates from all sites/departments
  - Update logs using internal or CHCANYS templates
  - Support IC in validating/updating objectives for next operational period
  - Prepare content for internal briefings and CHCANYS/VEOCI reporting
  - Track operational resource gaps if assigned by IC
  - Provide staff with timely updates
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## Extended Actions (12+ Hours & Demobilization)

- Support restoration planning (EOP Section 4)
  - Collect all logs and reports for recordkeeping (EOP 3.5)
  - Support IC during debriefing and hotwash (EOP 9.2)
  - Identify capability gaps and improvements
  - Prepare AAR inputs (EOP 9.2)
  - Assist IC with phased demobilization of ICS roles
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## Documentation & Reporting

- Use internal CHC reports or CHCANYS Report Template
- Maintain consolidated, timestamped Situation Status Log (EOP 3.5)
- Ensure alignment across departments and sites
